You will soon have a surgery in our dental office. Your dentist may have to perform a blood drawing the day of the surgery.

Why ? Your blood will be taken just before the surgery and immediately centrifuged. Your dentist will retrieve a small concentrate (a fibrin clot, very rich in growth factors).

What for ? These clots will protect your wounds, promote healing, reduce the post-operative pain, decrease the risk of infections and accelerate the bone regeneration.

Are we drawing a lot of blood ? No, about the same amount as for blood tests. There is no more tiredness to fear after the surgery.

Are they contraindications ? NO ! All patients can benefit from this technique. There are no contraindications. On the contrary, health problems can make this procedure an essential contribution to a good healing.

Nothing can replace your blood !

There are biomaterials (human, animal or synthetic), that may be added to your blood. But only your blood can bring you as efficiently and naturally all the growth factors necessary to your healing. Moreover, there are no risk of rejection to fear, as it's your own blood.

This natural technique requires the discomfort of a blood drawing but will greatly facilitate your healing and help your body to grow bone and gum in resorbed sites.
